
# Methodology

The survey was administered to all students through Google form and communicated to the class-wise Telegram groups which were created just after the completion of admission process, 270 (15.71 %) students participated in the survey. The questionnaire comprised twenty-one (21) questions covering various aspects of teaching, learning methods and evaluation processes.

# **Key Findings:**

### 1. **Teaching Quality:**

• 82.6 % of students noted that teachers prepare satisfactorily for the classes



 92.7 % of students have reported that teachers are satisfactorily able to communicate. 3. How well were the teachers able to communicate?

 94.1 % of students expressed that teacher's approach to teaching is good or very good or excellent.




• 77.4 of the students expressed satisfaction with the overall quality of teaching.



 79.2 % of students have reported that more 50 % of teachers use ICT tools while teaching




## 2. **Learning Experience:**


• 66.8 % of students have reported that that college takes active interest in promoting field visits




• 83.7 % of students noted that the teachers illustrate concepts through examples and applications



 79.6 % of students noted that their teachers inform them about Programme outcomes(PO), Course Outcomes (CO) and expected competencies required to secure employment




 77.7 % of students were felt that college provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow.




# 3. **Evaluation Methods:**
